The area

Nueva Andalucia is the most graceful little sister of Puerto Banus. This very nice and quiet residential area is within walking distance of the beach and the famous marina. It was deliberately built with ease and traditional Andalusian architecture in mind, as the name suggests.

With the majestic decor of La Concha Mountain, Nueva Andalucia is characterized by terracotta villas, exclusive whitewashed and gated community and luxurious modern apartment complexes lined with lush pine trees and manicured flowerbeds. To do

Nueva Andalucia is ideally located a few minutes from the bustle of Puerto Banus, the beautiful surrounding beaches and the bustling centre of Marbella. Infrastructure

Nueva Andalucia is a small area that stretches inland shipping from Puerto Banus and is easily accessible from the main coastal road. It also has good bus connections with routes to all major coastal areas including Marbella, Fuengirola and Malaga.

From Puerto Banus Marina there is also a boat to and from Marbella, a great travel alternative during the summer months! The service runs regularly from Easter until the end of November.

From Malaga airport and the train station there is a connection of the Costa del Sol with the rest of the world, and it can be reached by car in less than an hour.

Health care

There are some fantastic medical facilities in and around Nueva Andalucia. One of the largest and best hospitals on the coast, the Costa del Sol Hospital is only 15 minutes away.

Residents of Spain have full access to free health care by the National Insurance System. The public health facilities in Spain enjoy a great reputation and most of the medical care centers and hospitals offer their services with a free translation service.

European citizens who have a European health insurance card will have access to health care without having to stay in Spain.

Private health care care is also available at very reasonable prices. You will find a number of providers that advertise in the local press. Among the most popular are Mapfre, Cesar and Sanitas.

Education

The Costa del Sol is known for its cosmopolitan flair. You will find many international schools, nurseries and kindergartens.

Aloha College, a British International School, has an excellent reputation and offers education for students from 3 to 18.

There are very good Spanish public schools, and a number of international private schools, including Spanish, English, Swedish and German schools can be found.
